

BALLYHOO TAX AND LICENSE INFORMATION

Artists must have a **Baldwin County Business License** and will conduct their own sales. **Each artist will receive a tax package at check-in and turn in City taxes to GCAA at the end of the festival day.** Please obtain the county license by January 31. The deadline to apply for Ballyhoo is January 15.

After submitting your Ballyhoo Artist Application, make sure your Jury Fee payment is submitted as well.

BOOTH INFORMATION AND SET UP

1. **Setup will be from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on the FRIDAY, before the festival.** Your art can remain packed In boxes inside your tent or it can be set up as it would be for display. We will have a uniformed security guard for the Festival site overnight from 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
2. We will not allow large storage containers in back of the tents .However, your vehicles will be close by for additional storage.
3. **ALL TENTS MUST BE WEIGHTED DOWN TO ALLOW FOR THE POSSIBILITY OF WIND.** The island can get very windy.
4. **The Festival will begin at 9:00 a.m. and judging will begin at 10:00 a.m.** We have asked the judges to make the awards as soon as possible for ribbons to be put in your space for the rest of the show.
5. Ballyhoo Festival will be over at 5:00 p.m. **Artists are required to stay until the show closes.** Early breakdown with eliminate future acceptance to the festival.
